
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Midday Somewhere 2017 Shiraz



Grapes for these wines are grown only in the premium sub regions of Limestone Coast which are best suited to each wine style. The wines are then blended before bottling to a fresh, fruit driven style which is perfect for everyday drinking - or more salubrious occasions.

Background

Fruit for the Midday Somewhere Shiraz is sourced from a selection of premium vineyards within the renowned Limestone Coast region.

This area has incredible diversity in climate and geography which makes it perfect for nurturing vines that go on to create dynamic and complex wines. Our Midday Somewhere Shiraz has benefited from such variety and subsequently showcases brilliant aromatic fruit notes balanced perfectly alongside soft vanilla hues from the quality French oak barriques.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Deep rich dark purple with bright red hues

Aroma: Dark fruits, spice, floral, sage, honey and

shortbread. Strawberries, violets with some brooding, savoury, spice adding complexity.

Palate: Bright red fruits of strawberry and raspberry.

Creamy, smooth mouthfeel. Fine acid gives finesse to the palate with some hints of tobacco

and spice adding savoury flavours.

Food Match: Roast lamb of course

Cellaring: 3 - 5 years.
