

FLAGSHIP G.V.B WHITE 2016

ORIGIN

The Semillon was planted in 1991 on the south facing Korhaan flats at 220 m above sea level. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes used in this blend come from the 28 year old Schaapenberg Vineyard. This single vineyard is planted some 320 m above sea level and directly south facing. The row direction is east-west and the vineyards are planted to 2 clones, 316 and 317. Both from the Loire Valley.

VINIFICATION

Both Semillon and Sauvignon grapes were hand-picked, the Semillon two days after the Sauvignon, whole bunch pressed and barrel fermented. Harvesting dates were 11 and 12 February respectively. The Semillon was fermented in 25% new Francois Frere barrels and the Sauvignon in old 500 litre barrels. The wines were matured for 9 months before being bottled on 17 December 2016. Due for release March 2019.

COMPOSITION

Sémillon 80% Schaapenberg Sauvignon Blanc 20%

ANALYSIS

Al: 13.95 % RS 1.79 g/l TA 6.57 g/l Ph 3.07

MATURATION

Drink now or up to a decade after the vintage.

TASTING NOTE

Tight, focused and beautifully integrated with herbal (fynbos), grapefruity flavours, ripe tropical notes and a long, focused aftertaste. Enjoy with fresh seafood. Probably our wine of the vintage and without a doubt one of the great white wines of the world.
